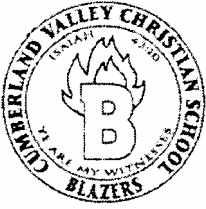

Cumberland Valley Christian School: Calling for Volunteers in Christian Service

Dear Parent:

Through the years, Cumberland Valley Christian School has had the privilege to educate and mold many great young people into great adults. It has been effort of CVCS to encourage the young people entrusted to the school toward the knowledge and life of Jesus Christ.

CVCS<sup>2</sup> is designed to recognize and encourage high-school students for serving and focusing on others. CVCS<sup>2</sup> is a voluntary program where students will receive credit for hours they volunteer at their churches, in their communities, and at their school. This information will be included on students' official transcripts and will be used to recognize outstanding CVCS students who serve.

Reasons for the program, among others, include:

- Many public schools around the country are requiring community service hours in order to receive a diploma, and we should recognize what our students do.
- Many universities are now asking for what students do outside the classroom and often specifically ask for how many hours someone has volunteered and/or served in their community.
- We recognize students for their excellence in academics and athletics, and we want to recognize students for their heart of service as well.

This program is open to all students in ninth through twelfth grades since these are the grade levels which appear on official transcripts. Faculty at CVCS will be filling out forms for when students volunteer for activities at the school. Forms are also available to students for recognition of what they do outside the school.

Because this is a voluntary program, any service to be recognized must be without wages. The only exception is service done as a camp counselor at a Christian camp. Enclosed is the form for CVCS<sup>2</sup> recognition. More forms can be gotten from Mr. Kent Lundy as needed. Records will be kept, and students are welcome to inquire about their total hours. If students serve the school while school is in session, students will be credited for one hour for every two worked. Otherwise, each hour a student actually worked will be credited for each hour.
